7th & 8th Grade Math (Mr. Heuer)

- One subject notebook (with perforated edges, not spiral), college-ruled
- ruler with centimeters and inches
- compass
- protractor
- calculator (some recommended calculators that are the least expensive are the Texas Instruments TI-25X or Texas Instruments TI-30Xa. These can be found at Wal-Mart usually in the electronics section).

Freshmen Speech and English:

- Set of three highlighters (minimum)
- Black ink pens (no gel pens) and pencils (if mechanical pencils are desired, bring extra lead); keep some pens at home
- 50 lined 3x5 note cards for speech
- Dry-line Liquid Paper (this is in tape form, not liquid)
- two-pocket folders with brads (1 green, two any other color); secure 10 sheets of lined notebook paper in the green folder (if preferred color is not available, choose another color. DON'T STRESS!)
- Lined paper in a binder/divided (may use the same one for speech and English) OR two perforated notebooks specifically designated for speech and English
- \$5.00 for partial cost of Scholastic's Scope magazine (English)
- 1 ream of 8 ½ x 11" paper (500 sheets)
- 1 large glue stick

Sophomores:

- Set of three highlighters (minimum)
- Black ink pens (no gel pens) and pencils (if mechanical pencils are desired, bring extra lead); keep some pens at home
