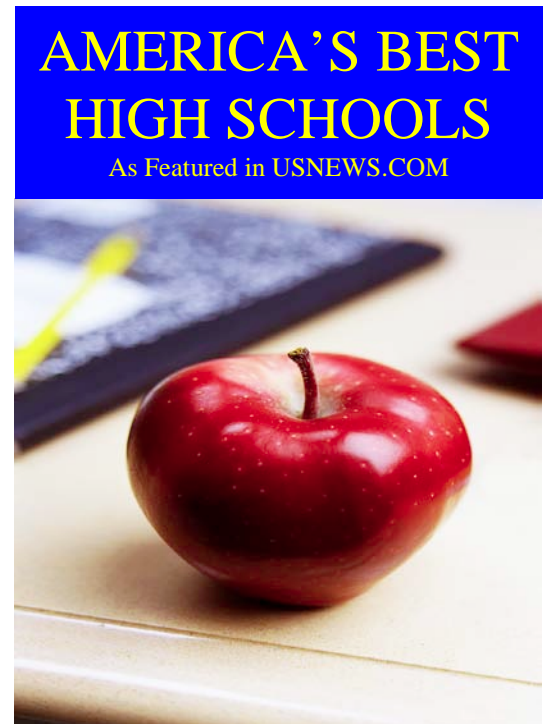

OUR SCHOOL

Hanover is a K-12 community with a total enrollment of approximately 150 students. Elementary classes average ten students per classroom. This small and **personal** setting has helped contribute to our academic success and has allowed us to set high expectations for our students.

Hanover Public School is a **safe** place for children and adults. The **warm** atmosphere creates a **welcoming** environment for learning and achievement.

Hanover High School has the unusual distinction of being a school where high achievement and **success** both academically and athletically are expected.

Hanover High School is **unique** in the opportunity it offers teachers, the opportunity to do what they **love** – teach. The average tenure in urban and some suburban schools is less than three years; the average **tenure** in Hanover is over 10 years.

Along with the usual array of course offerings, Hanover High School offers **outstanding**, well established vocational and fine arts electives. In addition to having national champions in FCCLA and FBLA, Hanover boasts a strong FFA, NHS, STUCO, and a Distinguished Service Program. Hanover has strong athletic programs which include high school and junior high offerings in volleyball, football, basketball, cheerleading, and track. Golf is also offered for high school students.

The entire campus at Hanover is equipped with wireless internet. This technology allows students in any of our classrooms to access the internet using laptops from one of our three mobile computer labs. These mobile labs compliment our two desktop computer labs and provide us with Distance Learning Network (DLN), allowing students to take dual-credit classes as well as provide alternative learning options for those who need them. Teachers utilize digital whiteboards and interactive student response systems.

PRESTIGIOUS HONORS

Hanover High School (HHS) has received prestigious academic awards from a number of organizations. HHS recently received the Governor's Achievement Award for the third consecutive year (06, 07, 08.) This honor is only awarded to the top 5% of all schools in the state. Hanover is one of only six public high schools in Kansas to receive this award every year that it has been obtainable. HHS was named one of the top high schools in the nation by U.S. News and World Report in both the November 2007 and 2008 issues.
